FARMERS' WEATHER WARNING: ALERT ON NORMAL RAINFALL AND SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS EXPECTED ACROSS LIMPOPO PROVINCE.

The Limpopo Department of Agriculture and Rural Development wishes to alert the farmers about an issued yellow, Level 4 warning for above-normal rainfall with severe thunderstorms over Limpopo Province. This rainfall may develop to a level 5 warning.

This kind of rainfall has a high potential of causing damage to Agricultural infrastructure. Farmers are warned to take care of Agricultural equipment, especially water pumps and other properties that can be damaged by flooding. Care should be given to livestock as well, by moving them to areas less susceptible to floods in their farming areas.

People should avoid unnecessary travel since some of the bridges may be dangerous due to overflowing rivers and dams. Above normal rainfall is predicted over Mopani and Vhembe districts. This will also cover areas within the Capricorn districts, Sekhukhune, and the entire Waterberg district.
