CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 39,68% to R4330/ton due to a decrease in volumes, however this trend may change in the short-term as a result of seasonal trends.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 43,32% to R8700/ton. Prices are, however, expected to decline until June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 6,37% to R12850/ton. Low stock level has led to the current onion price which

may likely normalise or level-out as volume increases.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 10,20% to R5830/ton. Prices are expected to remain flat in the short to medium-term due to stability of supplies.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 23,00% to R9740/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
