CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 29,73% to R3970/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and possibly move upwards supported by demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 48,16% to R8890/ton. Prices are expected to slide in the short term and level out in the medium term due to changing volumes.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 13,20% to R9430/ton. Low stock level has led to this increase in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes stabilise.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 31,69% to R6150/ton. Prices are expected to follow a stable to slightly upward trend within the medium term.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 73,88% to R18380/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
