CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 4,71% to R2020/ton due to increase in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 8,79% to R3110/ton. Prices are, however, expected to slightly decline until end of July where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 13,61% to R8760/ton. Decreasing stock level has led to the current onion price which may normalise or level-out as demand increases.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 21,37% to R7760/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 13,33% to R9550/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and possibly move further downwards as supplies improves.
