CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 10,44% to R6000/ton due to expected minimal fluctuations over the short term with a possibility of a slight decrease in the medium term.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 22,22% to R6600/ton. Prices are expected to trade flat with a possibility to further increase in the short-term as volumes may rise.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 7,69% to R14000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly stabilise due to higher volumes in the market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 0,95% to R8500/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 2,50% to R8200/ton. Prices are likely to stabilise and slightly decrease due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
