### **CABBAGE UP**

Prices increased by 57,89% to R4500/ton due to a decline in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

### **CARROTS UP**

Prices increased by 48,98% to R5900/ton. Prices should fluctuate in the short-term before moving lower due to higher volumes.

### **ONIONS UP**

Prices increased by 7,14% to R15000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly decline due to higher volumes in the market.

### **POTATOES DOWN**

Prices decreased by 3,79% to R7900/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 3,60% to R69000/ton. Prices are likely to remain flat due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
