CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 33,24% to R2650/ton. Prices may level-out in the short term supported by sufficient supplies & demand.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 10,01% to R8000/ton. Prices are expected to move sideways in the medium term supported by good supplies.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 1,37% to R9300/ton. Low stock level has led to this increase in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes stabilise.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 5,69% to R5800/ton. Prices are expected to trade sideways to downwards in the short-term in line with seasonal trends & on the back of higher volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 6,96% to R17100/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
