CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 11,66% to R6700/ton due to expected minimal fluctuations over the short term with a possibility of a slight decrease in the medium term.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 9,09% to R6000/ton. Prices are expected to trade flat with a possibility to further increase in the short-term as volumes may rise.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 14,28% to R12000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly stabilise due to higher volumes in the market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 7,29% to R9120/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 1,22% to R8300/ton. Prices are likely to stabilise and slightly decrease due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
