CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 38,88% to R2500/ton. Prices may possibly move sideways supported by anticipated good supplies.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 18,75% to R3900/ton. Prices are, however, expected to further decline where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 13,88% to R4100/ton. Low stock level has led to this increase in the onion market. The price may normalise as volume rises.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 18,42% to R6100/ton. Prices are expected to remain flat in the short to medium-term due to stability of supplies.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 18,75% to R7800/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
