### **CABBAGE DOWN**

Prices decreased by 6,30% to R2080/ton due to a increase in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

### **CARROTS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 6,68% to R3350/ton. Prices are, however, expected to further decline until end of June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

### **ONIONS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 8,50% to R10350/ton. Increased stock level has led to the current onion price which may normalise or level-out as demand increases.

### **POTATOES UP**

Prices increased by 3,76% to R7170/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 3,75% to R5800/ton. Prices are expected to increase slightly in the short-term and level-out in the medium term due to lower supplies.
