CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 12,76% to R2940/ton. Prices may level-out in the short term supported by sufficient supplies & demand.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 12,96% to R5240/ton. Prices are expected to move sideways & decline in the medium term supported by good supplies.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 1,71% to R8020/ton. Rising stock level has led to this decrease in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes stabilise.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 5,16% to R4960/ton. Prices are expected to trade sideways to downwards in the short-term in line with seasonal trends & on the back of higher volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 52,32% to R780016360/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
