CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 60,00% to R7200/ton due to a decline in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the medium term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 10,16% to R6500/ton. Prices should fluctuate in the short-term before moving lower due to higher volumes.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 13,33% to R13000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly decline due to higher volumes in the market.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 1,31% to R7500/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 4,34% to R72000/ton. Prices are likely to remain flat due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
