CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 13,20% to R2300/ton. Prices may level-out in the short term supported by sufficient supplies & demand.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 6,12% to R7510/ton. Prices are expected to move sideways in the medium term supported by good supplies.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 9,24% to R8440/ton. Low stock level has led to this increase in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes stabilise.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 10,00% to R6380/ton. Prices are expected to trade sideways to downwards in the short-term in line with seasonal trends & on the back of higher volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 13,85% to R14730/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
