CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 7,20% to R2680/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and possibly move downwards supported by anticipated good volumes.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 3,58% to R3780/ton. Prices are, however, expected to further decline where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 2,43% to R4000/ton. Low stock level has led to this rise in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes improves.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 0,98% to R6040/ton. Prices are expected to remain flat in the short to medium-term due to stability of supplies.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 17,3% to R9150/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
