### **CABBAGE UP**

Prices increased by 20,83% to R8700/ton due to a decline in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by reasonable supplies and demand.

### **CARROTS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 7,69% to R6000/ton. Prices are expected to move side-ways in the short-term before declining due to rising volumes.

### **ONIONS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 7,69% to R12000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly stabilise due to higher volumes in the market.

### **POTATOES DOWN**

Prices decreased by 12,0% to R6600/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 4,34% to R72000/ton. Prices are likely to remain flat due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
