### **CABBAGE UP**

Prices increased by 82,17% to R4190/ton. Prices may level-out in the short term supported by sufficient supplies & demand.

## **CARROTS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 5,19% to R7120/ton. Prices are expected to move sideways in the medium term supported by good supplies.

#### **ONIONS UP**

Prices increased by 2,01% to R8610/ton. Low stock level has led to this increase in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes stabilise.

## **POTATOES DOWN**

Prices decreased by 24,13% to R4840/ton. Prices are expected to trade sideways to downwards in the short-term in line with seasonal trends & on the back of higher volumes.

#### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 39,44% to R20540/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
