CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 76,31% to R3470/ton due to a decrease in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 19,92% to R6310/ton. Prices are, however, expected to decline until June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 7,14% to R15450/ton. Low stock level has led to the current onion price which

may likely normalise or level-out as volume increases towards June.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 0,32% to R6230/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 9,58% to R6980/ton. Prices are expected to increase slightly in the short-term and level-out in the medium term due to lower supplies.
