CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 41,67% to R8500/ton. Prices are expected to level-out & possibly experience minimal fluctuations over the short term with a possibility of a slight decrease in the medium term.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 10,00% to R5500/ton. Prices are expected to trade flat with a possibility to further increase in the short-term as volumes rise.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 50,00% to R15000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly stabilise due to higher volumes in the market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 13,63% to R7500/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 28,57% to R18000/ton. Prices are likely to stabilise and slightly decrease due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
