CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 7,35% to R2190/ton due to a decline in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 9,55% to R3900/ton. Prices are, however, expected to slightly decline and level out in the short-term to medium-term.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 65,97% to R13510/ton. Decreasing stock level has led to the current onion price which may normalise or level-out in the medium-term.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 55,55% to R6160/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 12,89% to R6820/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and possibly move further downwards as supplies improves.
