### **CABBAGE DOWN**

Prices decreased by 7,42% to R2120/ton due to increase in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

### **CARROTS UP**

Prices increased by 1,18% to R3410/ton. Prices are, however, expected to slightly decline until end of July where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

### **ONIONS UP**

Prices increased by 115,96% to R7710/ton. Increased stock level has led to the current onion price which may normalise or level-out as demand increases.

### **POTATOES UP**

Prices increased by 7,98% to R9870/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 15,27% to R11020/ton. Prices are expected to level-out in the short to medium term due to lower supplies.
