CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 5,97% to R2840/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and possibly move downwards supported by anticipated good volumes.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 12,76% to R4240/ton. Prices are expected to slightly rise in the short term and level out in the medium term due to changing volumes.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 39,25% to R5570/ton. Low stock level has led to this rise in the onion market. The price may normalise as volumes improves.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 23,01% to R4650/ton. Prices are expected to follow a stable to slightly downward trend within the medium term.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 28,85% to R11790/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
