CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 5,03% to R3801.30/ton due to a decrease in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 25,69% to R6 082,22/ton. Prices are, however, expected to decline until June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 9,32% to R8 303,52/ton. Decreased stock level has led to this increase in the onion market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 14,04% to R6084,48/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

TOMATOES UP

Prices increased by 25,96% to R10 819,04/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
