### **CABBAGE DOWN**

Prices decreased by 22,99% to R6700/ton due to a rising volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by reasonable demand.

### **CARROTS DOWN**

Prices decreased by 10,00% to R5400/ton. Prices are expected to move side-ways in the short-term before declining due to rising volumes.

### **ONIONS UP**

Prices increased by 8,33% to R13000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly stabilise due to higher volumes in the market.

### **POTATOES UP**

Prices increased by 27,57% to R8420/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

### **TOMATOES UP**

Prices increased by 3,89% to R8000/ton. Prices are likely to remain flat due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
