CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 30,13% to R2850/ton due to a decline in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 1,53% to R3960/ton. Prices should fluctuate in the short-term before moving lower due to higher volumes.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 3,62% to R14000/ton. Prices are expected to level-out and then possibly decline due to higher volumes in the market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 28,24% to R7900/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 2,34% to R6660/ton. Prices are likely to remain flat due to the uncertainty of volumes & seasonal trends.
