CABBAGE DOWN

Prices decreased by 50,08% to R2 227,31/ton due to an increase in volumes, associated with a decrease in the demand. This may also be associated with the closing of public schools, since cabbage is the basic commodity in school feeding schemes.

CARROTS DOWN

Prices decreased by 35,73% to R4 533,95/ton. Prices are still expected to decrease until end of June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS DOWN

Prices decreased by 0,8% to R10 023,58/ton. Increased stock level has led to this decrease in the onion market.

POTATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 23,18% to R5 566,94/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 30,72% to R6 602,84/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
