CABBAGE UP

Prices increased by 17,39% to R4462.21/ton due to a decrease in volumes, however this trend is expected to level out in the short term, supported by sufficient supplies and demand.

CARROTS UP

Prices increased by 16,0% to R7 054.92/ton. Prices are, however, expected to decline until June where larger volumes may stabilise the price.

ONIONS UP

Prices increased by 8,61% to R10 104.61/ton. Decreased stock level has led to this increase in the onion market.

POTATOES UP

Prices increased by 19,10% to R7 246.32/ton. Volumes are expected to level out and then rise, following seasonal trends and supported by lower volumes.

TOMATOES DOWN

Prices decreased by 11.91% to R9 530.09/ton. It is anticipated that prices may move sideways to downwards in line with seasonal trends.
